Working as a member of a small, multi-national team in a challenging environment, the successful candidate, will support the Compliance Manager, Science Manager, and the Observer Programme Coordinator (OPC) in the day-to-day administration and checking for quality of the Commission ROP data collection. He/she maintains the Commission ROP data collection system, monitors its quality and provides regular reports to the OPC on these matters. This includes input current and historical data relating to ROP, verification and checking on quality of all data entries at the time of input, monitoring the day-to-day operations of the ROP data collection scheme, liaison with other staff and managers of the Commission on related data and observer data matters, reporting on ROP data entries completed weekly to the OPC and acting as the point of contact for all Conservation and Management Measures (CCMs) related to the ROP.
