The WCPFC invites applications for the position of ICT Manager to be based at its headquarters at Pohnpei, Federated States of Micronesia. Working as a key member of a small, multi-national team in a challenging environment, the successful candidate, who will report to the Executive Director, will take responsibility for the Commission's information management and security, systems design, data management and communication technology and applications. In addition to the normal corporate demands of an international organisation headquartered in a relatively remote island location the ICT Manager will provide critical support to database development and management in respect of fishing vessel operations in the western and central Pacific including the development and administration of satellite-based systems for monitoring fishing operations and the possible future application of electronic systems for tracking catch. In addition to having proven strengths in ICT policy development and strategic planning, the appointee will drive technical developments – largely related to database development and administration, web-based systems and applications and modern communication technology.
